Talking Points Step-by-step Support

Why use it? Talking Points is for <u>written communication</u>, and helps us quickly and easily communicate with families in their home language. Families can use the app or simply receive our messages as texts. They respond in their home language, and messages arrive to educators in our preferred language.

I'm not techy - is it hard? No!

Do families see my personal phone number? No.

Does it take a long time? Initial set-up only takes a few minutes. Adding multiple students/classes can take a little longer, but is relatively easy to do. Once you're set up, communication is as quick and easy as texting/emailing. You might want to start with just a small group to practice.

Recommendations for use:

- Set up your Talking Points account using the steps below easiest on an iPad or phone, but can also be done through www.talkingpts.org.
- Let families know to expect text updates.
- Use Talking Points for ANY family (not just multilingual families). You can also send announcements to an entire group when you organize them in a class.
- Ask your Family Cultural Advocate or Equity & Personalized Learning Coach for support!





Initial Set-up:

- On iPad or iPhone: Navigate to the app store (on Android device, navigate to Google Play Store).
- Search "Talking Points" and download the Teacher version.
- Open the app, and select the teacher option.
- Click "Create new account."




- Create your account using your farmington.k12.mn.us email address, or use your school Gmail.
- Follow the prompts to add your name, position, grade level(s) and school.

- Click "Add students & contacts"
- Fill in the fields for your student and their contacts (people who will receive your messages).
- Click "+Add a new contact" at the bottom to connect more than 1 person (multiple parents/caregivers) to a student's profile.
- Save! (upper right corner)




Sending messages:


- In the Messages tab, click the blue pencil to start a new conversation (top right).

Sending announcements:

- Use the app's announcement feature (home screen, bottom center) to send messages to everyone in a group/class.
- This functions like email, but goes to parents/caregivers as a text.
- You can add polls and attach files/images/Google docs if needed.
- The app also has templates that will personalize your message to each recipient in the group.
