SECURE PRINT MacBook

1) Open **Word** (or Outlook is ok too) because it has full printer options available.

• Click the File menu and select Print.


We are going to use Word to set up the printer functions and save it as a pre-set. Then this 'pre-set' will be available to other applications like Chrome that do not have full printer options available.

- Choose the printer you want.
- Select **Output Method** from the 3rd drop down menu.
- Click SEE DETAILS box to see all drop downs if they are not there.
- Select SECURE PRINT.

To retrieve the print job at the printer:

Log in on printer as usual - using your ID card or network user id and password.

- Select SECURE PRINT Box, then OK.
- A keyboard is displayed and you may enter the ID and Password you used.
- Your print jobs are displayed. Press SELECT ALL to print all of them then PRINT, START.
- Be sure to return the Ecopy to its original state by pressing the RESET or LOG OUT.


Back at your computer:

If everything printed ok - then save the settings as a pre-set.

- Select "Save Current Settings as Preset"
- Give it a unique name.
